PRE-ANESTHETIC BLOODWORK

Like you, our greatest concern is the well being of your pet. Your pet is scheduled for anesthesia and/or surgery. Young or old, pre-anesthetic bloodwork is crucial to ensure the health of your pet prior to surgery. Your pet will receive an examination before surgery by a veterinarian. However, there are many conditions that cannot be detected with a physical exam alone. Many of these conditions can occur in pets that appear happy and healthy, and they can cause dangerous complications.

Our veterinarians recommend pre-anesthetic bloodwork in ALL pets, even puppies and kittens, for all of the following reasons:

- To confirm that your pet's organ systems are functioning properly and to detect hidden illnesses
- The information we gather from the bloodwork can help us reduce risk by adjusting our anesthetic and pre-operative protocol.
- To establish baselines that can help us detect illness more quickly in your pet for years to come. While reference ranges for each value have been established, they are simply averages across all breeds of animals of all ages for that particular species. Our software allows us to graph changes in every value analyzed every time your pet gets bloodwork, allowing us to detect **trends**, which is crucial for early disease detection.
- To enable us to detect disease in senior pets that are more at-risk. Pets that are **7 years of age and older** should without a doubt have pre-anesthetic bloodwork performed.
- Peace of mind. Pre-anesthetic testing can be very reassuring.
